We raise awareness among our teams and customers

- Our director, who is also the company's environmental manager, has completed specific training on the challenges of sustainable tourism, environmental preservation and CSR.
- All of our teams are also involved and aware of these issues. They know what actions to take in their daily tasks.
- We encourage our customers to adopt eco-friendly practices as well.
- We encourage travel by public transport and/or bicycle.
- We are equipped with charging stations for electric cars.
- We inform our customers about the various walking trails in the surrounding area.
- With strong local roots, we are delighted to help you discover our region and local partners: we share with you the activities and leisure opportunities available near our hotel.
 - All our cleaning products are eco-labelled.

We save water

- We have installed water savers/pressure reducers on taps and showers Our toilets are equipped with volumetric flushes.
- We check our water meters every month to better manage our consumption and have set up a table to track our consumption.
 - We change sheets and towels on request.

We save energy

- We check our energy meters every month to better manage our consumption and have set up a table to track our consumption.
- We purify the air in our fitness room using a JVD purifier and we control the air quality in this room, a meeting room and a suite using Airthings sensors.
- We have been using the District Heating Network since 2022.
- Our rooms and meeting rooms are equipped with individual thermostats.
- We have sensors/timers to limit energy waste.
- We are replacing all light bulbs with LED or low-energy bulbs and have already equipped more than 85% of our lighting.
- Our establishment's windows are double-glazed.
- We have an in-house laundry facility and prioritise eco-friendly washing programmes.

We limit and sort waste

- We have installed several internal sorting points (recyclable/non-recyclable). Glass is disposed of in a special bin and food waste is collected separately by Veolia
- We work with mostly bulk or large-format products to limit unnecessary packaging (e.g. welcome products are in large formats)
- We have completely banned the use of plastic bottles. We offer our customers water in glass bottles or jugs filled with tap water.

We strive to offer you sustainable food.

- Thanks to our in-house restaurant, all our dishes are homemade and we choose local and organic producers for our ingredients as much as possible. We can adapt to any type of diet.
- We control our restocking to avoid food waste as much as possible. Each product or dish is transformed or reused to aim for zero food waste.
